ASU members across Air New Zealand have overwhelmingly voted in favour of the Agreement negotiated

What was the ballot result?

95% of Air New Zealand employees voted yes to the new 2011 agreement.

What are the new wage increases & improved working conditions?

- casual loading increased to 25%.
- 3 year agreement.
- 3.7% per year increase to your base rate.
- 3.7% per year increase to allowances.
- Higher Duties to be paid as per the roster with applicable penalties or public holiday rates applied.
- Commitment to no split shifts.
- Positive space tickets for staff travelling to JCC or staff training domestic.
- Travel time to be paid for staff travelling domestic for JCC or staff training.
- Staffing levels to be addressed.
- Staff attending roadshows will attract time off in lieu.

- Part time hours minimum raised to 12 hours per week.
