Gold Coast Cabs Union Members' Bargaining Survey July, 2011

Your Gold Coast Cabs Collective Agreement was not registered through Fair Work Australia in June 2011 due to technical breaches of the Act by Gold Coast Cabs.

The Better Off Overall Test (BOOT) was not applied in this instance and your ASU representatives have ongoing concerns over the outcomes delivered in the proposed Agreement.

The process from here is to recommence negotiations for the Agreement to ensure that all of the technical processes are followed to avoid similar problems in the future. As such, your ASU representatives are seeking your views to ascertain what the next step in the negotiating process should be.
