Your EBA Negotiations Are Well Underway at TattsBet

Management and your Delegates have now sat at the bargaining table for a number of meetings to consider your Log of Claims. We will hear from TattsBet on the details of what they are seeking from you at the next meeting.

In a nutshell, we know that they want to completely change the way shifts are given, we know they want to remove many of your hard fought and won conditions around shift allocation.

What is important to you is very important to your negotiators. You would know that TattsBet will not let information be freely distributed in the workplace. You could ask what are they afraid of. TattsBet will tell you that they will let ASU material be distributed, **but it has to be approved by them first.**

We need a better way to communicate with you. Meetings will be called from time to time to provide an opportunity for face to face contact, but we need to be able to get information to you and seek your feedback in a much speedier fashion.
