Your ASU Delegates have considered all that is on the negotiation table and what Uniting Care Health have put into the document they want you to vote on.

Without a doubt, this offer is not fair, it is not reasonable and Uniting Care Health are trying to force you into taking an Agreement by threatening to keep changing the date for your back pay.

We don't think this is acceptable.

You have every right to want to continue to bargain for a fair Agreement, a fair wage increase and decent conditions.

There may be an increase to some classification levels, but less than one half of all employees will receive that increase which is equivalent to only 1%.

Lets add up the offer:

- Less than the national average wage increase.
- Less than half get the value of a classification increase.
- No-one gets the value of fixing a timeframe to reviewing the classification structure in total.
- No-one should accept that Uniting Care health can just keep changing the date for your back pay.
