



ASU Brisbane Report Back on the Australian Air Express (AaE) Joint Airport Consultative Committee (JACC)

Your ASU representatives attended a JACC meeting on 8 November, 2011. At this meeting the front counter concept design was discussed.

Management indicated that all concept designs needed to be concluded by the end of November, 2011 and requested that staff provide feedback on the front counter design by noon, Friday 11 November, 2011.

- Domestic staff members in attendance offered their views regarding the design layout.
- International staff members were not present in that meeting, but offered their views via the ASU to management within the required time.

Your ASU representatives also sought more information on the steps taken by AaE to ensure the proposed concept designs for the new airport facility have/will be assessed from a Occupational Health and Safety viewpoint, and how that approval process will be undertaken.

To date, management have not been clear on the timelines for assessment on all areas and plans under OH&S. It is imperative that any plans be assessed and that any changes that are recommended are implemented to ensure worker safety in the new environment.

The next meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday 16 November, 2011 and is earmarked as being the last for 2011.

- Kitchen and breakout room
- Amenities and Locker rooms
- Front Counter Layout and Training room
- Shed layout and in floor scale placement
- AVI Cage
- Location of water coolers; battery charging etc.
